



Sisvel announces new conditions for its DVB-T2 Licensing Program for Professional Products

Stuttgart, 9 May 2018 – Sisvel Germany announced today that the following conditions apply to DVB-T2 Licensing Program for Professional Products:

- Any sale or purchase of unlicensed DVB-T2 Professional Products and manufacturing of DVB-T2 Professional Products before Jan 1, 2017 is not taken into account for royalties to be paid;
- For professional products having a sales price greater than 1,000 €*, it applies the below royalty rate for Licensed Professional Products; while for professional products having a sales price equal to or less than 1,000 €*, it applies the below royalty rate for Licensed Consumer Products:

Type of DVB-T2 Licensed Product	Standard Royalty Rate Per Unit	Royalty Rate Per Unit for compliant licensees
Licensed Consumer Product with one of Encoder or Decoder function	€ 0.75 (seventy-five Eurocents)	€0.60 (sixty Eurocents)
Licensed Consumer Product with both Encoder and Decoder functions	€ 1.00 (one Euro)	€0.80 (eighty Eurocents)
Licensed Professional Product with one of Encoder or Decoder function	€ 18.00 (eighteen Euros)	€15.00 (fifteen Euros)
Licensed Professional Product with both Encoder and Decoder functions	€ 24.00 (twenty-four Euros)	€20.00 (twenty Euros)

** if a product is sold in a currency other than euro, the equivalent value of € 1,000 in that currency will be considered*

In addition, Sisvel Germany is pleased to announce Early Bird conditions for companies signing the DVB-T2 license agreement for professional products within 6 months of notification letter but, in any case, no later than Dec 31, 2018. For such companies the following additional conditions apply:

- 50% discount will be applied to royalties due for unlicensed products sold/purchased, etc. in 2017;

The DVB-T2 standard was published in the form of a Blue Book by the DVB Project in June 2008 and converted into the formal standard EN 302 755 by the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (“ETSI”) in September 2009.
